Academy Awards in Science and Technology

Bangladesh Academy of Sciences (BAS) announces the following awards in Science and Technology for the years 2012, 2013 and 2014

1. BAS Gold Medal Award 2012

Two Awards, one for Physical Sciences including Engineering & Technology and another for Biological Sciences including Agriculture & Medicine, will be awarded in each of the following two groups:

- a) Senior Group for Scientists aged 40 or above on 31 July 2014
- b) Junior Group for Scientists below 40 years on 31July 2014

2. BAS-Dr. Sultan Ahmed Choudhury Gold Medal Award 2013

For a distinguished scientist involved in research and development in the field of Medical Sciences.

3. BAS-Dr. M.O. Ghani Memorial Gold Medal Award 2013

For a distinguished scientist in the field of Physical, Biological, Engineering and Agricultural Sciences.

4. BAS-TWAS Young Scientists Prize 2014

The Bangladesh Academy of Sciences (BAS) and the World Academy of Sciences (TWAS) considering the necessity to foster scientific and technological cooperation among developing countries have agreed to work together within the framework of TWAS Prizes for young scientists scheme.

The candidates working in the different fields of Natural Sciences have to fulfill following requirements:

- i. The candidate must be below 40 years of age on 31 July 2014
- ii. The candidate must hold a university degree (minimum qualification is a Master's degree)
- iii. The candidate has to work and live in Bangladesh
- iv. The candidate should have a good record of research publications in the internationally recognized journals.

Bangladeshi scientists and technologists who have distinguished themselves by their outstanding scientific and technological work may apply for the above awards. Heads of Research Institutions/respective Deans of Universities/Fellows of the Bangladesh Academy of Sciences may nominate candidates for the Awards or candidates themselves may apply through their Heads of Institutions directly. Each nominee/candidate is required to submit 10 (ten) copies of his bio-data, list of publications and patents and a reprint of each of important publications.

Note: Those who were awarded Gold Medal in any of the above categories earlier are not eligible for nomination. However, gold medal awardees in category 1 under junior group may be nominated for senior group, if eligible.

Application for the above awards must reach the Secretary of the Academy by 31 October 2014 at the latest.
