Academy Awards in Science and Technology

Bangladesh Academy of Sciences (BAS) announces the following awards in Science and Technology for the years 2013, 2015.

1. BAS Gold Medal Award 2013

Two Awards, one for Physical Sciences including Engineering & Technology and another for Biological Sciences including Agriculture & Medicine, will be awarded in each of the following two groups:

- a) Senior Group for Scientists aged 40 or above on 31 May 2015
- b) Junior Group for Scientists below 40 years on 31 May 2015

2. BAS-National Professor Dr. M. Innas Ali Memorial Gold Medal Award-2013 For a distinguished scientists with outstanding achievement in any branch of Science and Technology

3. BAS-TWAS Prizes for the Young Scientists of the Developing world for 2015 The Bangladesh Academy of Sciences (BAS) and the Academy of Sciences for the Developing World (TWAS) considering the necessity to foster scientific and technological cooperation among developing countries, have agreed to work together within the framework of the TWAS PRIZES FOR YOUNG SCITNTISTS SCHEME.

The candidates working in the different fields of Natural Sciences have to fulfill following requirements.

- i. The candidate must be below 40 years of age on 31 May 2015
- ii. The candidate must hold a university degree (minimum qualification is a Master's degree).
- iii. The candidate has to work and live in Bangladesh
- iv. The candidate should have a good record of research publications in the internationally recognized journals.

Bangladeshi scientists and technologists who have distinguished themselves by their outstanding scientific and technological work may apply for the above awards. Heads of research institutions/ respective Deans of Universities/ Fellows of the Bangladesh Academy of Sciences may nominate candidates for the awards or candidates themselves may apply through their Heads of institutions directly. Each nominee/ candidate is required to submit 10 copies of their bio-data, list of publications and patents and a reprint of each of the important publications.

Note: Those who were awarded Gold Medal in any of the above categories earlier are not eligible for nomination for any of the categories. However, gold, medal awardees in category 1 under junior group may be nominated for senior group, if eligible.

Application/nomination for the above awards must reach the Secretary of the Academy by 31 May 2015 at the latest.
