- 1) The resolutions of the Meeting# BPGS-2012/02 held on 28 February 2012 have been confirmed.

- 7) The Board has reviewed the existing mode of M. Sc./M. Engg Thesis/Project procedure. After a wide discussion, the Board has taken the following decisions:
 - (i) Theis/Project Proposal: The concerned student will present his/her thesis/project proposal in a BPGS meeting. However, at most three proposals will be presented in a single meeting. Any interested person can attend the presentation of the proposals only. This decision will effect from the 27th March, 2012.
 - (ii) Thesis Pre-defense: The existing practice of pre-defense will remain unchanged. According to the existing procedure, the supervisor will arrange the pre-defense in the presence of all internal members of the board of examiners. However, any interested person can attend the pre-defense although only the members will decide on the necessary changes of the thesis work. The supervisor will circulate a notice before the pre-defense and the student will provide a report of minimum 10-page length to the internal members of the board of examiners.
 - (iii) Introduction of a seminar course: The Board has decided to introduce a non-credit seminar course in the postgraduate curricula of the Department to upgrade the research and presentation skill of the postgraduate students.
